Transportation

Airports:

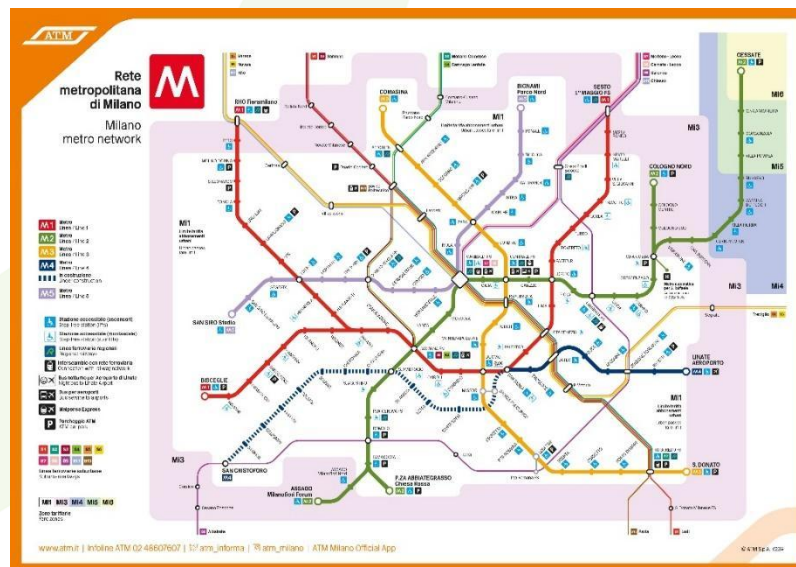
- 1) Milano Malpensa
- 2) Milano Linate
- 3) Bergamo Orio al Serio

Depending on which airport you will arrive to and fly from, you have different options to reach the centre of Milano:

- From Milano Malpensa you can use the train service Malpensa Express, which brings you to Milano main station (Milano Centrale) within 1 hour (cost 10 €);
- From Milano Linate you can either take a train (S5, S6, S9) or the M4 metro line, which reaches the city within 15-20 minutes;
- From Bergamo Orio al Serio you can use one of the many shuttles to reach Milano main station in approximately one hour. Shuttles are parked right in front the arrivals' exit at the airport, you will find them easily.

Public transportation:

Within the city of Milano, we recommend using the public transportation network and particularly the subway (metro, M) or the tram (suburban train, S).



A simple ride costs 2,20 € and can be purchased directly with contactless bank card. Further options include 3-days tickets or multiple-rides tickets, which you can purchase through mobile app or at the stations.
