Main research fields are: public finance, infrastructure policy, ecological & cultural economics.

Stela Bošković graduated from the Faculty of Economics in Podgorica and earned her Master's degree from the Faculty of Economics at the University of Belgrade. She began her career at Montenegrobanka and later held several managerial roles at the Central Bank of Montenegro, Société Générale / Podgorička Banka, and Crnogorska Komercijalna Banka (CKB). At the Central Bank, she worked in bank supervision and systemic risk control. She later served as Advisor to the CEO and Director of the Corporate Secretariat at Podgorička Banka. Since 2022, she has been a Member of the Management Board of Crnogorska Komercijalna Banka, responsible for corporate and legal affairs and bank security, and since 2025 also leads Corporate Governance and ESG.

Sanela Metjahić has over 16 years of experience in ecology and European integration, and has been working in the Ministry responsible for environmental protection since 2010. From 2010 to 2020, she worked in the Directorate for Waste Management and Municipal Development, contributing to the development of strategies, legislation, alignment with the EU acquis, and international cooperation.

Since 2020, she has been engaged in international cooperation and EU funds, focusing on coordinating the EU accession process and implementing projects. She currently serves as Head of the Directorate for International Cooperation and EU Integration. She is also a member of the Coordination Body for the Reform Agenda and the Working Group for Chapter 27 – Environment and Climate Change.

Based on Scientific Committee evaluation, an abstract or paper can be rejected or accepted by the Conference Chairs.

A Book of Abstracts will be published following the conference.

By providing the chance to submit full research papers for publication, the conference hopes to promote the exposure of the research presented at the site on a global scale. Selected full papers from the Conference will have an opportunity to be published in the Journal of Regenerative Economics (<https://crossreis.com/journal.html>).

Note: only full paper submissions apply for the inclusion in the journal's special issue.
